Messiah in the Passover

The speaker will arrive 30 to 45 minutes prior to the service to complete the final preparations of the demonstration table. The presentation will be done from a table rather than from a pulpit. It should be a LARGE 'SUNDAY SCHOOL' STYLE OF TABLE (5 to 6 feet in length) and covered with a WHITE TABLECLOTH.

Preparation Instructions for a Demonstration with or without Communion

"I Can't Find Matzoh! What do I do?"

If you live in a Jewish area, boxes of matzah slices (not matzah meal) will be readily available at the local grocery store. If matzah is not usually stocked at your store:

- Ask the grocery store manager to order a box for you. Common brand names are Streit's, Manischewitz and Horowitz Margareten.
- Or, ask a local Jewish deli or synagogue where you can purchase some.

It is essential that three whole, unbroken slices of matzah be available for the demonstration.



If, after following the above suggestions you are still unable to obtain matzah in your area, please advise the speaker at least one day prior to the meeting.

The items listed below will also be needed. Each one is important and will be used in the service.

- 1. Two **CHAIRS** (dining room style if possible), one at each end of the table. One chair should have a **PILLOW** on it (a bed pillow is adequate).
- 2. On the table we will need five **CLEAR BOWLS** (dessert size), each holding the following items or groups of items (i.e., one bowl for the stems of parsley, one for the egg, etc.):
- a) one APPLE, peeled, finely chopped, allowed to turn brown and mixed with a little HONEY, a few CHOPPED WALNUTS and a bit of CINNAMON;
- b) six or seven STEMS OF PARSLEY;
- c) one **HARD-BOILED EGG**, in the shell;
- d) **SALTED WATER**, enough to half fill one of the dessert bowls;
- e) four or five tablespoons of white or red bottled **HORSERADISH**
- 3. Also needed on the table are:
- a) two 10- or 12-inch white, **DRIPLESS CANDLES** with simple **CANDLEHOLDERS** and **MATCHES**;
- b) an ordinary Coffee Spoon;
- c) one or two ordinary dinner-sized SERVIETTES;
- d) one clear glass filled with RED GRAPE JUICE;
- e) three slices of unbroken MATZAH (not pita bread).

We ask that you supply the above items because of the difficulty of transporting them. We appreciate that your congregation is doing everything possible to make this an effective and successful presentation.
