


Dear Friends:

Mon., Feb. 26 – Toronto / Israel
We will meet our Canadian Gateway rep at Toronto Pearson
International Airport in the Air Canada Departures' area,
Terminal "1", where our group will check in.

Tues., Feb. 27 -- Tel Aviv, Israel

Arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, early where our Guide will assist us with customs and immigration along with the transfer of luggage before boarding our motorcoach. We will visit Joppa (Jaffa) where Jonah fled from the Lord and where he was swallowed by a whale. Continue to Simon the Tanner's House where Peter was hosted and where he performed a miracle of raising Tabitha from the dead (Acts 9). Next, we will stop at Ramat Gan Messianic Center where we can have lunch and tour the center Following dinner this evening, an Orientation Meeting is planned where we will have any questions answered about the Holy Land program. Dinner and overnight at the Ramada Hotel, Netanya.


Wed., Feb. 28 - Caesarea / Mt Carmel / Galilee B/DFollowing an Israeli breakfast continue up the coast to Caesarea, built by King Herod the Great in 22 B.C.E. Included in our visit will be the Roman Theatre in which Paul was tried by Festus (Acts 25: 6-12), the Roman Aqueduct and the Herodian Port. Driving north, we arrive atop Mount Carmel and the Mukhraka, where Elijah faced the prophets of Baal and brought down the fire of God (I Kings 18), affording us a magnificent panorama of Carmel, the mountains of Samaria, Gilboa and Gilead. Proceed to Megiddo, the ancient guard city of the Jezreel Valley and the future site of the Battle of Armageddon. Our next visit stop will be Nazareth Village, a recreation of a first century village which brings to life what a small Galilean village was like in Jesus' time. We will then board our bus and continue on to Tiberias to check in at the Leonardo Club for dinner and overnight...

Thurs., Feb. 29–Capernaum / Tabgha / Mt. Beatitudes B / D This morning we will experience some reflective moments and prayer on a boat while cruising the Sea of Galilee. We will disembark at Capernaum and see the many ruins at this site which was the centre of Jesus' Galilean Ministry and the site of many of His Miracles (Mark 2:4; Matthew 8: 5; 14–17; Luke 4: 31. Our bus will then take us on to Tabgha, a traditional place where Jesus served breakfast to His Disciples after the resurrection and then on to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered a most significant sermon "The Sermon on the Mount". (Matthew 5). Our tour will continue to the ancient Jewish town of Korazim, mentioned in the scriptures. Continue to Nof Ginosar where we will view the ancient "Jesus Boat" at the Yigal Alon Center. Our last site today will be a visit to Magdala. Return to the Leonardo Club, Tiberias, for dinner and overnight.

Fri., Mar. 01– Tel Dan / Caesarea Philippi / Golan

After breakfast, we will drive north visit Tel Dan and one of the sources of the River Jordan and the site of ancient Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made his confession of faith in the Messiah (Matthew 16:16). We will drive up to the Golan Heights (Joshua 21:27) arriving at Mount Bental where we can view the entire Golan Heights and Mount Hermon. Drive to the Gadot Outlook overlooking the Hula Valley and see old Syrian army bunkers. From here we will drive south to the Sea of Galilee to visit Yardenit for those who wish to be baptized in the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight at the Leonardo Club, Tiberias.

Sat., Mar. 02--Be'it Sean / Be'it Alpha / Jericho B / D
This morning we will leave Tiberias and visit the city of Be'it Sean
which is the largest ongoing archaeological site in the Land of
Israel. Travelling a little distance west, we will stop at Be'it Alpha
an ancient Byzantine village site which has the ruins of a
synagogue that displays a beautiful mosaic floor. We continue
South along the Jordan Valley, to visit Jericho, revered as the
oldest city in the world. From Jericho we will have a breathtaking
view of St. George's Greek monastery built on the side of the
Mount of Temptation. We turn West along the Old Jericho
Road and visit the site where the Good Samaritan parable took
place. Arriving in Jerusalem we will stop at Mount Scopus for
our first view of Jerusalem, the City of Gold. Dinner and
overnight, at the Olive Tree Hotel, Jerusalem.



Sun., Mar. 03--Masada/Dead Sea/Ein Gedi/ Qumran B/D This morning we will depart from our hotel and drive to Masada and ascend to this mountaintop site by cable car to the ancient fortress. This is where the Jewish resistance group made their fated last stand against Rome after the fall of Jerusalem AD 73. Worship the Messiah Yeshua in Masada's ancient synagogue as we praise the Lord for His faithful preservation of His people and restoring them to their Promised Land over 70 years ago. We will stop at a spa resort to enjoy an experience floating in the Dead Sea. From here we will visit the lush Ein Gedi Nature Reserve to get refreshed with the fragrances of its flora and fauna. Next, we visit Qumran and view the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found before heading back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight at the Olive Tree Hotel.

Mon., Mar. 04–Jerusalem / Old City

We will start our day in Jerusalem with a drive to the top of the Mount of Olives where we will have a panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem and the Golden Gate. We will walk down the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus was arrested and betrayed by Judas. Our group will meet across the street in the private garden which will be opened by the gardener for us to enjoy meditation and some quiet time. Here we will visit The Church of All Nations. Our next stop will be the Upper Room — site of the Last Supper. We will then continue to the City of David where we will see a 3D movie and then on to Hezekiah's Tunnel after which we will visit the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount. Dinner and overnight at the Olive Tree Hotel, Jerusalem

Tues., Mar. 05-Elah Valley / Old Jerusalem B/D
Today we will visit the Valley of Elah Valley—best known as
the scene of the Biblical battle between David and Goliath. .
Continue to Old Jerusalem, the Western Wall and the
Rabbis' Tunnels, then the Burnt House and the Cardo.
Overnight and Dinner at the Olive Tree Hotel.

Wed., Mar.06-- Old Jerusalem

This morning we will visit the Be'it Sar Shalom Center, a ministry of Chosen People Ministries. Our next stop will be a visit to Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Museum, followed by the Israel Museum and Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. Nearby is the Holy Land Model which, in miniature, shows the city as it was in Jesus' day. We then return to the Jaffa Gate of the Old City to visit Christ Church, the oldest Protestant church in the Middle East and early on became known as the "Jewish Protestant Church". We will then conclude this day visiting the Garden Tomb, site of the burial and resurrection of Jesus. Here we will also celebrate Communion. Return to the Olive Tree Hotel, Jerusalem

Thurs., Mar. 07– Jerusalem / Leisure Day

This is a leisure day whnen we can relax, revisit sites and do some shopping. Optional Visits: Yad Vashem; House of Caiaphas; Pool of Bethesda. This evening, we will be together for our Farewell Dinner at the Olive Tree Hotel. This is when we will be reminiscing about our tour and show appreciation to our Guide and Driver. Return to the Olive Tree Hotel for overnight..

Thurs., Mar. 08 – Israel / Toronto, Canada B After an early breakfast, we will check-out of our hotel and transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our Air Canada departure to Toronto


