This year, Sukkot is the same, and yet terribly different. October 7, 2025, marked the two-year anniversary of the horrendous attack in Israel.

As I write, the release of the remaining hostages, alive and deceased, is being negotiated. Hatred of Jewish people and Israel is shown daily in violent chants, marches, and attacks across Canada and the world.

What the world needs now, is shalom! Now, you and I know that true shalom stems from reconciliation with God

through Messiah Jesus. Only He can bridge all divides, communal and personal.

As His followers, we're called to be agents of His peace in a divided world, sharing and demonstrating the Good News with Jewish people and the nations.

We're also called to stand with Israel and the Jewish people, even when that support is unpopular or misunderstood.

Let us be both messengers of peace and reconciliation, and people with the courage to confront hostility.

Highlights of the HAVERIM 2025 FRIENDS conference

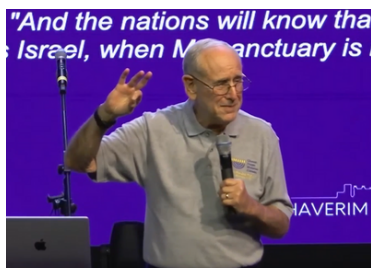
On September 12 and 13 in Toronto, we held HAVERIM 2025 FRIENDS, our annual conference. Our theme this year was "Israel's Friends and Foes: Unpacking Ezekiel 36-39."

Speakers Mitch Glaser, Robert Walter, and Jorge Sedaca showed how promises to Israel and the nations are clearly laid out prophetically in the book of Ezekiel. A panel discussion that included Pastor Daniel Muller gave the audience an opportunity to have their pre-submitted questions answered.

Throughout the event, Joshua Aaron led everyone in song in Hebrew and English, as Messianic dancers mirrored the lyrics through expressive movement, creating an atmosphere of joyful worship. Live testimonies from Israel showed the impact that Chosen People Ministries is having as we reach Israelis with the Gospel and minister to their needs.

Compared to 2024, this year's event saw many more young people in attendance. Also, a marked number of attendees said this was their first HAVERIM. We're already planning for next year!

A Jewish couple's journey-in-progress to faith in Yeshua

Recently, Marcello Araujo, one of our missionaries, has been meeting regularly with a Jewish couple, Brett* and Laura*, as they explore what it means to be a Jewish person and a follower of Yeshua.

They each asked, "If I become a follower of Yeshua, does that mean I stop being Jewish and become Gentile?"

Naturally, the idea of losing one's identity is hard to bear. Marcello is helping to dispel the misconception, while showing this precious couple the reality that the Gospel is "to the Jew first."

Laura had originally met with the pastor of a local church. When the pastor was unable to answer her questions about Jewish identity, he referred her elsewhere while continuing to address her questions as he is able.



Laura has already given her life to Yeshua, but Brett has not, as yet. Understandably, he is worried that his family would reject him and Laura or even sever the relationship if they were to express faith in Yeshua.

Marcello is counselling Laura on how to walk alongside Brett, staying true to Yeshua while giving her husband the space he needs to continue wrestling with big questions and life-changing decisions.

Brett has noticed and even commented to others about the amazing transformation he has seen in Laura, though not attributing it to Yeshua.

Please pray for Marcello as he continues to explore the Scriptures with Brett and Laura, expertly pointing out readings from the Tanakh to show how the Hebrew Bible contains the Gospel of Jesus.

When I was in Israel this summer, missiles fell day and night, and it was terrifying. Even so, I felt tremendous peace in the midst of it.

Most of the missiles lobbed at Israel by the Iranian regime were intercepted, but many of them struck and killed people and made others homeless in an instant.

Ultimately, my brothers and sisters according to the flesh—the children of Israel—can't afford to put all their confidence in the Iron Dome, David's Sling, or even their own IDF officers and soldiers.

In Psalm 20, David sings, "Some trust in chariots, and some in horses, but we will remember the name of the Lord our God."

Are they remembering His Name? Are they listening? Are they hearing?

We've heard reports of young Israelis showing renewed desire to read the Scriptures, in search of peace that political institutions have not been able to deliver.
