



God is in the details

One of the amazing aspects of Torah is the detail of God's instructions to Moses. The construction of the Tabernacle. The design of priestly garments. The selection of animals for sacrifice. Every detail is packed with meaning!

A beautiful example is the selection of the Passover lamb in Exodus 12. Each family was to select a male yearling from their flock of sheep. The selection was to take place on the tenth day of the first month, Nisan, and they were to keep the lamb alive until the fourteenth day, the day of sacrifice.

During this period, they were to inspect the lamb to be sure it was unblemished. Any defect, spot, illness, or broken bone, would render the animal unworthy for the sacrifice.

Here God was giving us a preview of what would take place centuries later, when

Jesus entered Jerusalem five days before Passover. He made a very public appearance riding on a donkey colt, in fulfillment of Zechariah 9:9, to shouts of 'Hosanna', echoing Psalm 118:26.

Over the next few days, Jesus answered questions of ordinary people and responded to Pharisees and Scribes in the Temple. They were testing Him to see if He really was God's Messiah. He passed the test, even if some didn't agree.

On the day of sacrifice, as the priests were slaughtering thousands of lambs for Passover, Jesus was crucified on Golgotha. The sinless, spotless Lamb of God was slain for the sins of the world, yours and mine included. Let's thank God that He **is** in the details. Happy Passover and Resurrection Day!

Hebrew word of the month

Our word this month is *HaGeulah* (“ha-geh-oo-LAH”), the third cup of the Passover.

The sequence of the Passover meal is based on the drinking of four ceremonial cups of wine, each representing one of the four divine actions of Exodus 6:6.

- The first cup: the Cup of Sanctification
- The second cup: the Cup of Plagues
- **The third cup: the Cup of Redemption**
- The fourth cup: The Cup of Praise

In Exodus 6:6, Adonai says, “...I will bring you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians. I will free you from being slaves to them, *and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment.*”

HaGeulah signifies much more than a financial transaction. The word implies a familial relationship between the one redeeming and the one being redeemed.



In the third action, Adonai says that He will redeem His kin by paying the price to bring the Children of Israel out of bondage, and He will do so with a display of superior might.

The third cup, *HaGeulah*, traditionally represents the slaying of the Passover lamb whose blood on the doorposts of each home signalled to the Angel to pass over them during the tenth plague.

Now imagine—on the night He was betrayed, after the supper of the Passover, Jesus lifted up *HaGeulah*, and said, “...This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you...” (Luke 22:20)

As the congregation got to know this younger couple, they all fell in love with them!

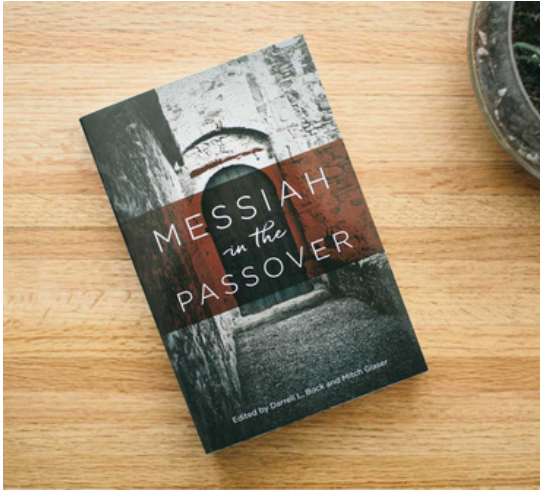
Joshua* has a wonderful reading voice, and Miriam* has become a regular Torah reader in Hebrew at the congregation’s services.

Messianic Passover Haggadah

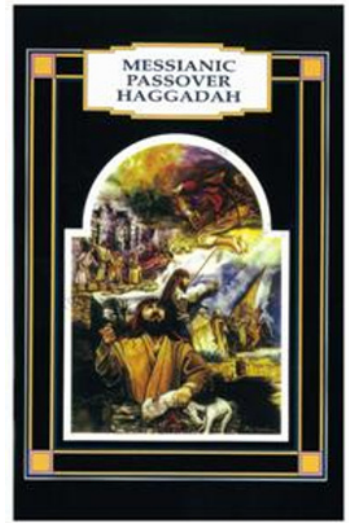
With this guidebook for holding a Messianic Passover Seder, you have everything you need pertaining to the order of service for this meaningful celebration.
